The Stove Shop of Liskeard, Cornwall, recommended **Honeywell** wireless controls for the new heating system, at a stately home in Devon. The controls were installed in a fraction of the time required by conventional wired controls, even given the vastness of the house. The heating system has five zones; four for space heating and one for domestic hot water. One space heating zone can provide 113,000 Btu of heating, two at 76,000 Btu and one at 15,000 Btu. Each zone is fed via a Honeywell motorised valve from a common manifold, served by two oil-fired boilers.

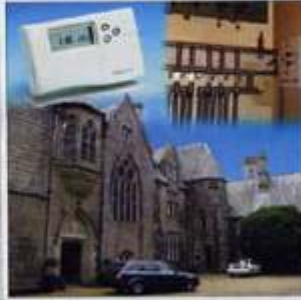

A no mess installation

When the owners of a stately home in Devon, looked to specify controls for a new heating system in their family living areas, they insisted on no visible wiring and no cable holes. Honeywell wireless controls were recommended by The Stove Shop, Liskeard,

who designed and installed the new heating system. The company fitted Honeywell's CMGRF wireless programmable thermostats, which use safe low power radio signals to automatically adjust the temperatures within different heating zones.

The Stove Shop designed a special wiring centre to control the boilers, valves and pumps in response to heat demand signals from the thermostats and a hot water cylinder thermostat. The delighted homeowners report that the controls are very easy and convenient to use.

Wireless controls prove ideal in Devon stately home

Honeywell wireless controls were recommended by The Stove Shop, of Liskeard, Cornwall, which designed and installed the new heating system. The controls were installed in a small fraction of the time required for conventional "wired" controls, particularly bearing in mind the vastness of the Victorian mansion, the thicknesses of its interior walls and the long distances up to the system's two boilers. These are installed with heating manifolds, control valves and a specially designed wiring centre in former servants' quarters on the top floor.
